[PROPOSED] ORDER APPROVING PLAN OF ALLOCATION

THIS MATTER having come before the Court for hearing on the motion of Class Representatives City of Bristol Pension Fund, City of Milford, Connecticut Pension & Retirement Board, Pavers and Road Builders Pension, Annuity and Welfare Funds, the City of Newport News Employees' Retirement Fund, and Massachusetts Laborers' Pension Fund, on behalf of themselves and the Class, for final approval of the proposed class action Settlement and approval of the proposed Plan of Allocation for proceeds of the Settlement; the Court, having considered all papers filed and proceedings held herein and otherwise being fully informed;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that:

- 1. This Order operates by reference to the definitions in the Revised Stipulation and Agreement of Settlement filed on May 20, 2019 (ECF No. 274-1) (the "Stipulation"), and all capitalized terms used, but not defined, herein shall have the same meanings as those set forth in the Stipulation.
- 2. Pursuant to and in compliance with Rule 23 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, this Court hereby finds and concludes that due and adequate notice was directed to Persons who are Class Members who could be identified with reasonable effort, advising them of the Plan of Allocation and their right to object thereto, and a full and fair opportunity was accorded to Persons who are Class Members to be heard with respect to the Plan of Allocation. There were no objections to the Plan of Allocation.
- 3. The Court hereby finds and concludes that the Plan of Allocation, set forth in the revised Settlement Notice (ECF No. 274-3) approved by the Court and disseminated to Class

Members, provides a fair, reasonable, and equitable basis upon which to allocate the proceeds of the Net Settlement Fund among eligible Class Members. The Court finds that the Plan of Allocation, as set forth in the revised Settlement 4.
